University of Advancing Technology (UAT) is committed to helping students pursue their educational goals through financial aid. Every student's path is different, and by participating in the Federal Student Aid (FSA) program, UAT helps provide access to grants, loans, and work-study opportunities.

WHO CAN RECEIVE FINANCIAL AID?*

Students must meet the following requirements to be eligible for financial aid at UAT:

- » Be accepted into a UAT associate, bachelor's, or master's program
- » Be a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen
- » Be enrolled at least half-time (undergraduate: 6 credit hours; graduate: 3 credit hours)
- » Not be in default on a federal student loan or owe a refund on a federal grant
- » Have earned a high school diploma or GED
- » Have a valid Social Security Number

TYPES OF FINANCIAL AID



SCHOLARSHIPS

Awarded based on merit, identity, hobbies, or service.



GRANTS

Need-based aid from federal, state, or institutional sources.



STUDENT LOANS

Funds repaid with interest, often lower than private loans.



FEDERAL WORK-STUDY

Paid on- and off-campus jobs supporting educational costs.



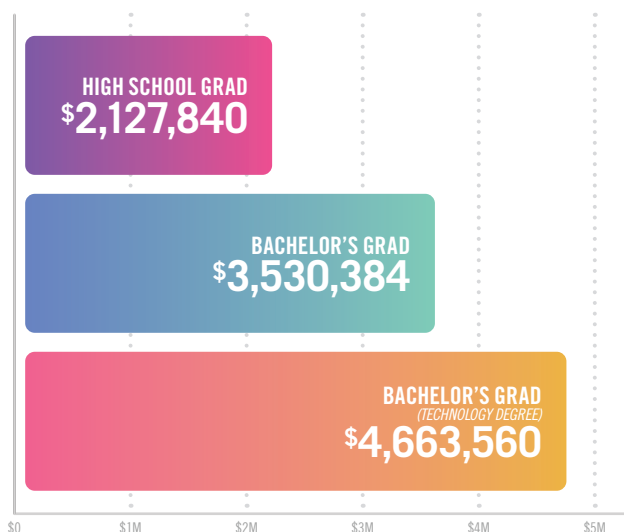

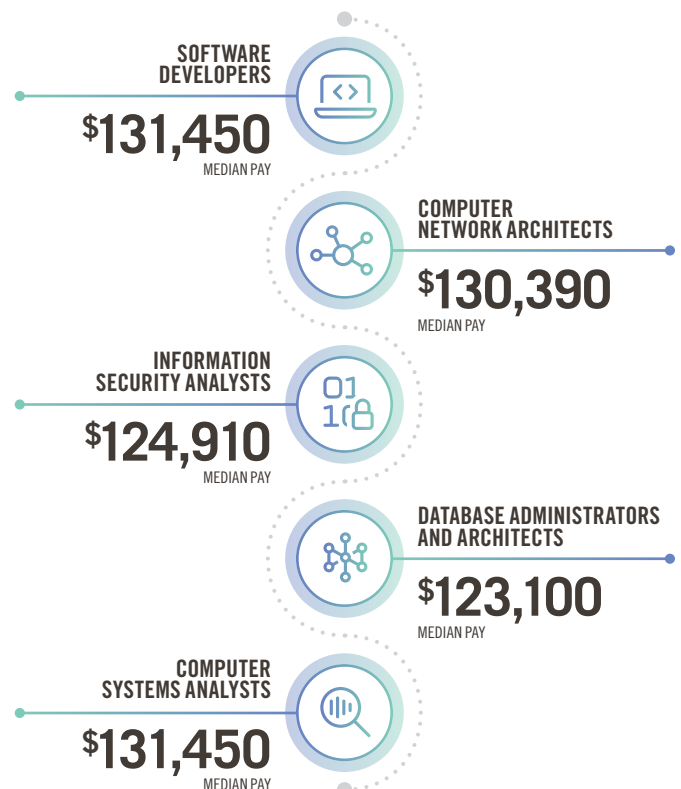

(Bachelor's degree)

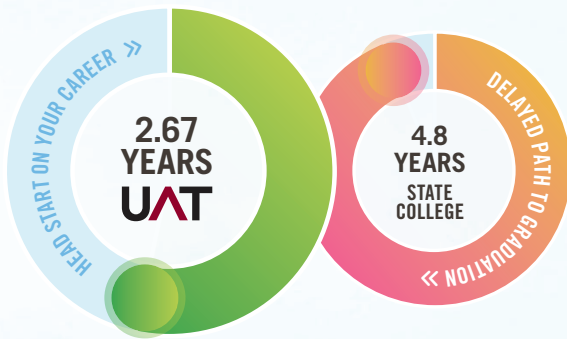


WHY CHOOSE UAT?

- » **Enter the workforce earlier:** By graduating sooner, graduates start earning an income sooner.

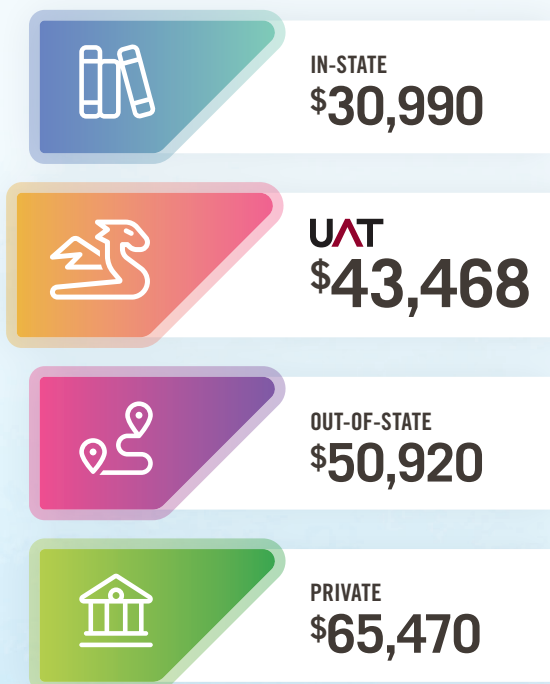
GRADUATE SOONER. EARN SOONER.*

Submit your FAFSA to begin the financial aid process.

02

RECEIVE YOUR FAFSA SUBMISSION SUMMARY

UAT reviews your summary to determine eligibility

STEP

03

GET YOUR AWARD

If you qualify, an award letter is sent to your primary email.

STEP

04

FINALIZE YOUR AID

Accept your award and complete required documents.
