

CAMPUS HAZING TRANSPARENCY REPORT

UAT is committed to maintaining a safe and secure learning and working environment for all students, employees, and guests. Pursuant to the Stop Campus Hazing Act, UAT has created and will update at least twice annually this Campus Hazing Transparency Report. The Report summarizes the findings of any student organization found to be in violation of UAT's Anti-Hazing Policy, and includes the following:

- Name of the student organization;
- General description of the violation, including whether the violation involved alcohol or drugs;
- Findings of the institution;
- Sanctions placed on the student organization;
- Date the incident was alleged to have occurred;
- Date investigation into the incident was initiated;
- Date investigation ended; and
- Date student organization was provided notice that incident resulted in a hazing violation.

Reports of hazing that did not result in a finding of responsibility are not included. UAT will maintain the information for five years following the date of initial disclosure.

2025 – 2026 ACADEMIC YEAR

Since July 1, 2025 there have been no student organizations found responsible for hazing violations.
